BC Housing, Vancouver Coastal Health, and the City of Vancouver have formed a partnership to address urgent housing and health service needs in Vancouver.

BC Housing intends to apply for a rezoning of the properties located at 1636 Clark Drive and 1321-1395 East 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue under policies in the Grandview Woodland Community Plan to permit the development of a mixed-use building comprised of approximately a 60,000 sq ft withdrawal management centre including 20 transitional housing units, 60 - 100 affordable housing units and a 3,800 sq ft social enterprise centre.

The project team will be hosting a pre-application open house at Vancouver Community College Broadway Campus on Monday, April 23, 2018 from 5:00 pm - 7:30 pm. The purpose of the pre-application open house is to introduce the preliminary proposal to the community in order to seek early feedback.

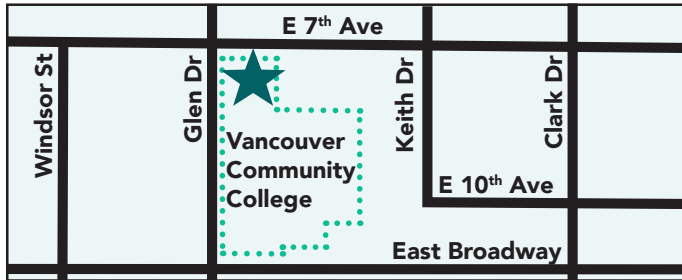
